

W. Rly Transported 1.20 Lakh Tonnes Of Essentials Through 529 Parcel Trains



Ahmedabad, During the crisis arisen due to COVID-19 Western Railway is ensuring its best possible efforts that there is no break in supply of essential commodities. Hence WR's parcel special trains are traversing across the country to keep the supply moving. In continuation to this, on 10th Sept, 2020, one parcel special train and a milk rake left from WR. These included a parcel special from Bandra Terminus to Jammu Tawi

and a milk special rake from Palanpur to Hind Terminal. According to a press release issued by Shri Sumit Thakur - Chief Public Relations Officer of Western Rly, transportation of goods by tapping new avenues are also being explored. It is a matter of great achievement that transportation of coal has found a new destination. Western Railway's Business Development Unit of Vadodra division has started loading of coal from Dahej to

Bharuch for the first time. The coal is loaded from M/s Adani Petronet Port (Dahej) Pvt Ltd (MAPD) in Gujarat to a new destination i.e M/s Gujarat Narmada Valley Fertilizer and Chemicals Ltd (GNFC) at Bharuch. The revenue earned through this transportation is Rs 15.84 lakh. The loading for this transportation was done recently and it will benefit the industries located in this region.

Shri Thakur further added that, since 23rd March to 9th Sep, 2020, commodities weighing about 1.20 lakh tonnes have been transported

by Western Rly through its 529 parcel special trains, which mainly included agricultural produce, medicines, fish, milk etc. The revenue generated through this transportation, has been approx. Rs 39.77 crore. During this period, 86 milk special trains were run by Western Rly, with a load of more than 65 thousand tonnes and 100% utilization of the wagons. Similarly, 408 Covid-19 special parcel trains with a load of above 39 thousand tonnes were also run to transport various essential commodities. In addition to this, 35 indented rakes carrying more than 15 thousand tonnes were also run with almost 100% utilization. During the lockdown period from 22nd March till 9th Sept, 2020, total 14,411 rakes of goods trains have been used by WR to supply essential commodities amounting to 30.13 million tonnes. 28,317 freight trains have been interchanged with other zonal railways, in which 14,162 trains were handed over and 14,155 trains taken over at different interchange points. The revenue generated through these goods trains is approx. Rs 3800 crore. The total loss of revenue over Western

Railway on account of Corona Virus, has been approx. Rs 2498 crore, which includes about Rs 378 crore for suburban section and approx. Rs 2120 crore for non-suburban. In spite of this, resulting to cancellation of tickets since 1st March, 2020 to 9th Sept, 2020, Western Railway has ensured to return refund amount of Rs. 426 crore. It's worth mentioning that in this refund amount, Mumbai division alone, has ensured refund of Rs 205.76 crore. Till now, 65.95 lakh passengers have cancelled their tickets over entire Western Railway & have received their refund amount accordingly.

On way to Haryana farmers' protest at Pipli, Meham MLA Balraj Kundu arrested, later released

Rohtak, Balraj Kundu, the Independent MLA from Meham, was arrested for four hours on Thursday for violating prohibitory orders as he and his supporters were headed for Pipli grain market near Kurukshetra to take part in the farmers' rally against the Centre's agriculture ordinances. Kundu, who was arrested at the Makrauli Kalan toll plaza only to be released hours later, said: "The police can't stop farmers from raising their voice against these ordinances. I will stand by my farmer brothers and protest against the government until these ordinances are revoked. These bills are being brought to sell farmers' rights to big corporates." Kundu, who left for Pipli with his supporters, condemned the lathicharge.

"This government is against the farmers. If political leaders can canvass in the Baroda constituency by defying the district administration's orders (on social distancing), why are farmers not being allowed to hold a rally?" he said. Tosham Congress MLA Kiran Choudhry

also took on Haryana chief minister Manohar Lal Khattar and state agriculture minister JP Dalal for preventing farmers from crossing toll plazas to reach Pipli. "The implementation of these ordinances will lead to the exploitation of farmers at the hands of corporate houses."

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Bihar medical aspirant shoots self while taking selfie with father's pistol

Patna, A 17-year-old medical aspirant in Bihar's Gopalganj district died after accidentally shooting himself in the head while trying to click a selfie with a firearm licensed to his father. The victim was identified as Himansu Kumar alias Kunal, a resident of Imalia village under the limits of Manjha Garh police station of Gopalganj district. The firearm belonged to the victim's father, Omprakash Singh, a farmer-cum-BJP activist. Police said the deceased was studying in Kota, Rajasthan and had recently returned to his native place during the lockdown. Imalia village head Ranjan Singh said Kunal accidentally pulled the trigger of his father's gun while posing for a picture at his home on Friday morning. Kunal's neighbour and former minister Ram Praveesh Rai said he called the police after hearing a gunshot. "I heard a gunshot, and then I heard somebody screaming. I realised that somebody had been hurt. I called the police straight away and when they arrived, they found that he (Kunal) was still alive," Rai said.
