Rs 500 crore blocked from Surat traders, police extortion scam to open bank accounts

Surat It has been shockingly revealed that the police of Maharashtra and Karnataka are demanding bribes to reopen the frozen bank accounts of diamond merchants and jewelers of Surat. The bank accounts of these traders doing business in other states were frozen in the name of cyber fraud. Because of this, the condition of traders has become dire as more than 500 crores of rupees are blocked.

After freezing the bank account, Maharashtra and Karnataka police officials called and demanded 10 to 20 percent rupees to unfreeze the account. 30 of the 50 bank accounts have been frozen by the Maharashtra police while the rest have been frozen by the Karnataka police. Diamond dealers are supposed to pay their purchase and sale bills on Diwali itself, but the dealers are in trouble as their bank accounts are frozen. The diamond traders of Surat together made a presentation to the Union Water Power Minister and Gujarat State President of BJP, CR Patil. This kind of incident happened a year ago too. According to the diamond merchants, this kind of act is being done by the police to extort money. It was also learned that some traders were forced to pay money to the police to open bank accounts.

Police transfers money through malatiyas Diamond merchants and jewelers from Surat trade in other states. Where payment is transacted after sending goods one to five times. Police transfers the money to the merchant's account who buys the goods. As soon as the transfer is done, the police freezes the bank account telling the buyer that 'cyber fraud money has been transferred to your account'. In this way, the accounts of

diamond and jeweler traders in Surat are frozen. The merchant is then called to the police station and a huge amount is demanded to unfreeze the account. Indian Diamond Institute Chairman Dinesh Navadia said that the money is transferred to the account of the party who bought the goods through the police. Then the bank account which has major transactions with the buying party is deliberately frozen. After that, the police calls and demands 10 to 20 percent of the money to reopen the bank account. A representation has also been made to Union Hydropower Minister CR Patil in this regard.

At Borsara village in Mangrol, gang rapes a minor, villagers take half-naked victim to hospital, 3 foreign accused identified

Bardoli, Who will save Deviswarupa children from malevolent demons in Navratrī? This question is being asked by every Gujarati today. After the gang-rape of Sagira in Bhayali, Vadodara, now there is outrage in Gujarat due to the incident of gang-rape of Sagira in the home district of the Minister of State for Home Affairs. Borsara village of Mangrol 3 Naradhams in Vadodara pattern first beat up the minor's friend and chased away the minors one by one. After being informed by the friend of the victim, the villagers reached and took the minor to the hospital in a semi-naked condition. These thugs also took the mobile phone of the victim and her friend after the crime. After the incident, the police have identified the three foreign accused.

Surat rural police chief Hitesh Joysar said that

between 10:45 and 11:15 pm last night, a 17-year-old and 4-month-old girl along with her friend were assaulted in a farm on the outskirts of Mota Borsaran village in Kosamba police station area. She was sitting on the ground. The police team of Kosamba, Surat Rural Dy.SP, LCB, SOG, Parole immediately reached the spot as soon as it was reported that 3 persons suddenly came along with repeated rape and attempted rape. Also, Range IG and SP also reached the spot and got information about the incident. More than 10 teams have been employed to investigate this incident. The police have taken the youth present with the minor to the spot and collected the necessary evidence. Also FSL's team is currently checking the spot. Medical check-up of the victim was done. The incident was very

sensitive, so all the teams are working since late night and the police is intensively investigating the incident. In this incident, the victim and his friend did not get any injuries, it is known that the usual two-three slaps were inflicted. Medical check-up of the victim has also been done and according to the new law BNS and BNSS, the police are taking action in this incident very sensitively and very quickly to solve this crime and to punish the three accused involved in this strictly. The victim and her friend's mobile phone were also taken away by Kosamba Police Station under Section 70(2), 115(2), Section 54, Section 309(4) of BNS which also includes robbery because the mobile phones of the victim and her friend were also stolen. Naradhamo has taken away. 352, 351(3) All these sections of BNS and

Section 4 and 6 of POCSO Act have been booked. Kosamba police inspector is the investigation officer in the case, and a special team has been formed. In which Dy.SP RR. A team of LCB PI, SOG PI, Payroll PI, AHU PI of Sarvaiya, Kamraj Division has been constituted. The police are intensively investigating the case. Sagira Keem had come to meet her friend. According to the victim, the three accused repeatedly raped her one after the other. Kim had come here to meet her friend from where the victim was studying and at 10:30 p.m. along with two other friends, they were going to a petrol pump on the highway on the way to Big Borsara to fill up on petrol. Meanwhile, he was sitting in the field on the road for some time. Then these people reached there and committed gang rape.
